OUR WHY | ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Problems we want to target in 2023.

Our new program, in collaboration with STEMforGIRLS and Quadrangle NL, will hope to address two key problems identified in our province:

PROBLEM #1

Lack of gender diversity and 2SLGBTQIA+ diversity in the technology sector.

Women are massively underrepresented in technical and leadership roles in Canada's technology sector (PwC, 2017). Research has also shown that when youth see technology as something that can be leveraged to make positive change it will increase their chances of a future working in a technology-related role (Microsoft, 2018).

Additionally, individuals who identify as 2SLGBTQIA+ experience more institutional barriers to work in the technology sector (QueerTech, 2022) due to social exclusion, harassment and lack of equal opportunities compared to their peers. Additionally, according to QueerTech, 57% of their respondents reported that they are not "fully out" at work, with 15% concerned that their career opportunities may be limited because of their sexual orientation.

The technology sector requires a diverse workforce to build our technological landscape into an equitable future, so ensuring that queer individuals not only enter the technology sector but continue in the field is essential to this sector's humane growth.

OUR WHY | ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

PROBLEM #2

Lack of visibility into local organizations, businesses and professionals that are queer-owned and queer-inclusive.

As of today, there is no single place to search for queer-owned/-inclusive organizations, businesses, and professionals located in Newfoundland & Labrador (NL). Those who are looking to support such businesses and organizations have to do their own research, which can be extremely difficult and time-consuming given the varied web presence and searchability of some businesses/organizations. This acts as a massive barrier to those consumers who want to support queer-owned organizations and contribute to their local queer-owned economy.

OUR HOW | ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Make real, positive impact while learning digital skills.

Our proposed program seeks to tackle these problems in one cohesive digital skills experience. This program will challenge girls and/or youth in the 2SLGBTQIA+ community to build a digital directory of queer-owned and -inclusive organizations, businesses, and professionals.

Each participant will learn the digital skills required to design and code a single-page website highlighting a queer-owned/-inclusive organization, business, or professional. The resulting pages will be combined into a cohesive directory, which will act as a proof-of-concept to gather further funding and support to build InQueeries.ca. InQueeries will not only serve the community as a searchable directory, but will also be a central information hub for all programs and resources available to the 2SLGBTQIA+ community in NL.

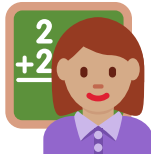

Our program will include three (3) components for registered participants, designed to foster growth of digital skills and peak interest in a future career in technology:

1

ONLINE BEGINNERS WORKSHOPS **Learn to Design & Code**



No prior web design or coding knowledge required. We'll teach participants everything they need to know to design and build their single webpage.

2

GET ONE-ON-ONE SUPPORT **Work With Industry Mentors**



Participants will receive additional support with their webpage from our diverse pool of local design and coding experts in NL's technology sector.

3

IN-PERSON/ONLINE LAUNCH EVENT **Show Off New Skills**



Participants will gather in-person or online to showcase the InQueeries app proof-of-concept, and mingle with their program peers, mentors, and other industry leaders.
